You are invited to join a research study to test the accuracy of four different step count trackers (Fitbit Zip, Fitbit Surge, Jawbone UP, and Jawbone Move) in people with Parkinson Disease.

You may be eligible to participate in this study if you:

- Have been diagnosed with Parkinson's disease
- Are able to walk without assistance for at least 10 minutes
- Are able to come to the Center for Neurorehabilitation at Boston University

Eligible participants would only need to complete a single session lasting

approximately 1.5 – 2 hours. During the session, participants will complete four different walking tasks that are meant to mimic scenarios in daily life.
