BU STEPS study for people with Parkinson Disease

You are invited to join a research study to test the accuracy of four different step count trackers (Fitbit Zip, Fitbit Surge , Jawbone UP, and Jawbone Move) in people with Parkinson Disease.

You may be eligible to participate in this study if you:

- **Have been diagnosed with Parkinson's disease**
- **Are able to walk without assistance for at least 10 minutes**
- **Are able to come to the Center for Neurorehabilitation at Boston University**

Eligible participants would only need to complete a single session lasting **approximately 1.5 – 2 hours**. During the session, participants will complete four different walking tasks that are meant to mimic scenarios in daily life.
