Erin R. Foster, OTD, MSCI, OTR/L is Assistant Professor of Occupational Therapy, Neurology, and Psychiatry at Washington University School of Medicine in St. Louis, MO. Dr. Foster received her Doctorate in Occupational Therapy and completed postdoctoral training in clinical neuroscience and cognitive neuropsychology at Washington University School of Medicine. During her postdoctoral fellowship, she was selected for a multi-disciplinary clinical investigation training program and received her Master's of Science in Clinical Investigation. Dr. Foster's research focuses on understanding how cognitive dysfunction in Parkinson disease (PD) impacts everyday life, cognitive rehabilitation approaches for PD, and general self-management in PD. She has federal and foundation research grants related to these topics. As a consultant with the Program in Occupational Therapy's Community and In-Home Services Practice, Dr. Foster helps guide therapists treating clients with Parkinson disease and related disorders.
