People with Parkinson's disease and their Caregivers Needed for Research Study



The University of Rhode Island's Lipid Lab invites people with Parkinson's disease and their caregivers to participate in a 4-part research study (~4.5 hours total) to collect information related to diet, access to health information and technology use. Inclusion Criteria:

- 18⁺ years of age
- Community dwelling
- English speaking
- Telephone access
- Participation of person with Parkinson's and their informal caregiver
- Informal caregiver is an unpaid friend/family member that provides majority of care
- No prior technology use or transportation access is required



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
