Optimism Award - Community Member

A community member nominee may be a PwP (Person with Parkinson's), a care partner, family member, support group leader, volunteer, donor/philanthropist, or individual with a passion for Parkinson's disease who is making a difference in the lives of those living with PD.

Optimism Award - Service Provider

A service provider nominee is a Parkinson's healthcare professional, including (but not limited to): physician, neurologist, neurosurgeon, physical therapist, speech therapist, occupational therapist, exercise/wellness facilitator, massage therapist, researcher, nurse, clinical research coordinator, educator, or other healthcare practitioner working in the fields related to Parkinson's disease.
